01 Consultation & Design

02 Planning

We will book a start date and plan out a schedule of work for a time that best suits you and your family. In the meantime, if you have not already done so, you may want to start looking and selecting tiles.

03 Product & Finishes Selection

We can supply all aspects of fittings from your basic taps, vanities, frameless shower screens etc to custom design vanities and cabinets or you can purchase your own and we will provide the labour to install.

04 Construction

Once work begins, we will take care of your home and property keeping it clean & tidy, arrange delivery of components and work within an agreed time-frame. Your Project Supervisor will keep you up to date throughout the entire process. In most cases, a bathroom renovation takes up to 3 weeks after work begins.

05 Bathroom Renovation Timeline

To be successful, your renovation has to follow a specific timeline:

Demolish - Strip-out labour & rubbish disposal. This process will take up to one day.

Builder will do any structural work or repair water-damage, if needed. The time will vary depending on the amount of work.

Carpenter will make modifications where necessary

Plastering – Re-lining walls & ceilings and installation of plain or decorative cornices

Plumber "roughs in" water pipes and drainage. If you're not moving your bath, shower or vanity, this can take less than a day. It will take longer if you are moving plumbing.

Electrician roughs in wiring. The plumber and electrician may be able to work at the same time if the work is not too complex.

Water-proofing: you may have to wait up to three days to allow the waterproofing membrane to cure. Water proofing is one of the most important steps in preparation for your bathroom renovation and we adhere strictly and conform to the Australian Standard AS 3740-1994.

Tiler Once the floor and walls are prepared the tiling will take place. Allow 4 days for the wall & floor tiling.

Shower screen installer will measure the shower enclosure space after the tiling completion. They will install the shower later.

Painting If we are doing the painting, it will be done prior to installing the fittings.

Plumber will return to install your fittings – Vanity, taps, toilet etc. If you choose a freestanding bath, it will be installed at this stage.

Electrician will return to do the electrical fit-out.

Final Fit-out - Shower screen, mirrors, towel rail, toilet roll holder accessories etc are installed.

06 Completion

Once your project has been completed we will conduct a final inspection to ensure your satisfaction so that you can enjoy your beautiful new bathroom.
